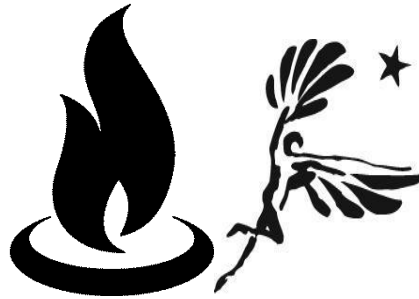

The award-winning, bestselling author of *An Everlasting Meal* revives and perfects 100 classic gourmet recipes in this illustrated cookbook. Other than the occasional kitschy resurrection, like of deviled eggs, or Oysters Rockefeller or Boeuf Bourguignon, many tastes that first awakened Americans to the pleasures of the table are nearly gone. Tamar Adler is glad some of the dishes and ideas from those days have disappeared-- her interest in cooking is rooted in wanting to overturn the idea of fine dining as complicated. But there are recipes she feels compelled to resurrect. Beneath the pretentious names, fussy garnishes, gratuitous sauces, and outmoded techniques, Adler finds the dishes themselves are good and worth keeping alive, they just need to be adapted to what we like now. The 100 recipes in this book are an expression of Adler's curiosity, and her affection for old and fading things. Adler is a columnist for the *New York Times Magazine* and a contributing writer for *Vogue*. She is the author of *An Everlasting Meal: Cooking with Economy and Grace*. Adler has won a James Beard Award and an IACP Award.

Ken Holmes worked in the Marin County Coroner's Office for thirty-six years, starting as a death investigator and ending as the three-term, elected coroner. As he grew into the job—which is different from what is depicted on television—Holmes learned a variety of skills, from finding hidden clues at death scenes, interviewing witnesses effectively, managing bystanders and reporters, preparing testimony for court to notifying families of a death with sensitivity and compassion. He also learned about different kinds of firearms, all types of drugs—prescription and illegal—and about certain unexpected and potentially fatal phenomena such as autoeroticism. Complete with poignant anecdotes, The Education of a Coroner provides a firsthand and fascinating glimpse into the daily life of a public servant whose work is dark and mysterious yet necessary for society to function. Bateson served as the executive director of a nationally-certified crisis intervention and suicide prevention center in the San Francisco Bay Area for 16 years. He is the author of three previous books—The Last and Greatest Battle, The Final Leap, and Building Hope.

In this stunning debut collection, Curtis Dawkins, an MFA graduate and convicted murderer serving life without parole, takes us inside the worlds of prison and prisoners with stories that dazzle with their humor and insight, even as they describe a harsh and barren existence. The Graybar Hotel tells moving, human stories about men enduring impossible circumstances. Dawkins takes readers beyond the cells into characters' pasts and memories and desires, into the unusual bonds that form during incarceration and the strained relationships with family members on the outside. He's an extraordinary writer with a knack for metaphor, and this is a powerful compilation of stories that gives voice to the experience of perhaps the most overlooked members of our society. Dawkins grew up in rural Illinois and earned an MFA in fiction writing at Western Michigan University, though he was accepted to Iowa, because he wanted to study with Stuart Dybek. He has struggled with alcohol and substance abuse through most of his life and, during a botched home robbery, killed a man on Halloween 2004. Since late 2005, he's served a life sentence with no possibility of parole in various prisons throughout Michigan. He has three children with his partner Kim, who is a writing professor living in Portland, Oregon.

Award-winning writer Jessica Harris takes readers back to the 1970s in the New York City, where her circle included Maya Angelou, James Baldwin, and various other members of the Black intelligentsia. With the lively world of Café Society receding into history and the dance clubs ushered in by the sexual revolution throbbing in the night air, New York was a city in transition—from legal segregation to white flight, from a city of Irish pubs to America's home for international cuisine. Using unprecedented, dramatically compelling sleuthing techniques, legendary statistician and baseball writer Bill James applies his analytical acumen to crack an unsolved century-old mystery surrounding one of the deadliest serial killers in American history. Between 1898 and 1912, families across the country were bludgeoned in their sleep with the blunt side of an axe. Jewelry and valuables were left in plain sight, bodies were piled together, faces covered with cloth. Some of these cases, like the infamous Villasca, Iowa, murders, received national attention. But few people believed the crimes were related. And fewer still would realize that all of these families lived within walking distance to a train station. When celebrated baseball statistician and true crime expert Bill James first learned about these horrors, he began to investigate others that might fit the same pattern. Applying the same know-how he brings to his legendary baseball analysis, he empirically determined which crimes were committed by the same person. Then after sifting through thousands of local newspapers, court transcripts, and public records, he and his daughter Rachel made an astonishing discovery: they learned the true identity of this monstrous criminal. In turn, they uncovered one of the deadliest serial killers in America. James made his mark in the 1970s and 1980s with his Baseball Abstracts. He is currently the Senior Advisor on Baseball Operations for the Boston Red Sox. James lives in Lawrence, Kansas.
